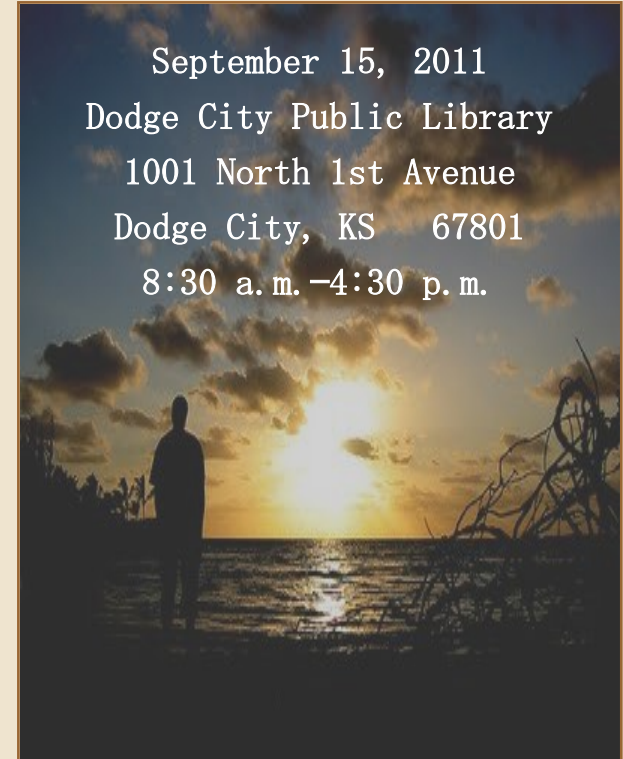

The Dodge City training is a collaborative effort of Addiction and Prevention Services of SRS, Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission and the Southwest Kansas Task Force on Problem Gambling.

Training Objectives

This training continues a prevention campaign to address gambling-related problems. This will be accomplished through education and public awareness.

- Participants will explore their own attitudes and beliefs about persons who experience problems with gambling.
- Participants will recognize the signs and symptoms of problem gambling.
- Participants will understand the magnitude and seriousness of problem gambling.
- Participants will understand the various types of gamblers, the phases of pathological gambling and will be able to describe various means of gambling.
- Participants will have an opportunity to practice giving a brief presentation to a small group.

Training Outcomes

Participants will leave the training prepared to provide presentations to clubs, churches, schools, civic, professional and business groups and for various lengths of time.

Participants will be provided with a presentation packet containing multiple options for presentations:

- A CD with a Power Point presentation and other options,
- A laminated presentation with suggested handouts, and
- Handouts that can be used for every presentation.
